600,000 people join global actions to #EndFossilFuels



Earlier this month, **hundreds of thousands of people answered a global call to action** and took to the streets with the demand to #EndFossilFuels. Across 60 countries, an estimated 600,000 people joined more than 700 protests and marches **to demand urgent climate action and the swift phase-out of fossil fuels.**

The scale of this worldwide mobilisation highlights the growing awareness of the climate crisis, **driven by this summer's record-breaking heat, devastating floods, and extreme weather events.**



Fossil fuels – coal, oil, and gas – remain the

biggest driver of climate change. The fossil fuel industry and its enablers are responsible for this crisis, perpetuating an exploitative economic system that harms both humanity and the planet.

The science is clear: **the world urgently requires a rapid and just transition to an efficient, fair, and universally accessible energy system built upon clean energy sources**, while respecting nature and the rights of Indigenous peoples and local communities. The onus lies on the leaders of wealthy nations to swiftly phase out fossil fuels and provide global funding for this transition.

We must build on this global mobilisation and keep up the fight for a fast and fair transition away from fossil fuels.
