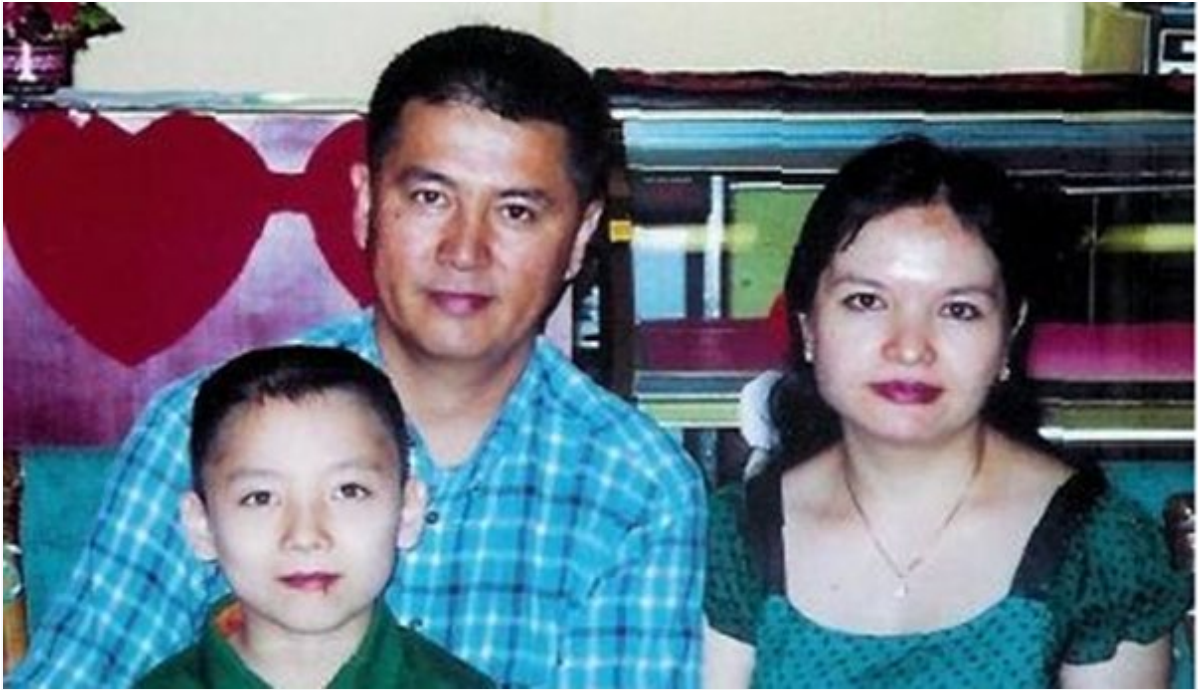
Last week saw the deadliest attack by Myanmar’s military junta on innocent civilians since the coup. The military junta claim they were targeting ‘terrorists’, but among almost 200 people who were killed were dozens of women and children. The youngest victim was just six months old.

We can’t help but ask, ‘how many more people need to die?’

Last week we briefed and met with UK parliamentarians, as they gathered to discuss the escalating human rights crisis in Myanmar/Burma. And we couldn’t agree more with Rushanara Ali MP that ‘to save lives, we need to ground the jets and helicopters by cutting their fuel lines’.

Reports emerge of Alimujiang Yimiti's release

If you've been supporting CSW for a long time, you may remember praying for a Uyghur Christian in China called Alimujiang Yimiti (known as 'Alim').

Last month, US-based organisation China Aid reported that Alim had been released from prison after completing a 15-year sentence on unfounded charges. The house church pastor had been detained since 2008, which a UN working group concluded was 'solely on account of his faith'.

Thank you for praying for Alim – even if it was many years ago – and for helping us draw international attention to his case. Now we pray that Alim will be able to resume his life with his family and friends with no further harassment from the authorities.



Free at last!

Professor Tarfa in Nigeria and Pastor Nadarkhani in Iran have both been released from prison!

So many of you have prayed and campaigned with us for these two men – for Professor Tarfa, since his arrest on Christmas Day 2019, and even longer for Pastor Nadarkhani – since his initial arrest in 2011, followed by over a decade of harassment and repeated unjust imprisonments.

We thank God that our prayers for freedom have been answered.
