To help the Job Club Manager with this initiative, we are looking to recruit up to 3 Job Club Coaches (volunteer roles)

Your role as a CAP Job Club Coach will be to assist and support the CAP Job Club Manager in the set up and running of the group. You will directly train, support and encourage job seekers and help them to find appropriate employment. All of this must be done in a way that positively reflects the Christian faith and the core values of the charity.

You'll usually decide your minimum time commitment with the CAP Job Club Manager, but generally, it's in the region of 2 to 4 hours a week, during the weeks your job club is running.

Because this role can involve working with vulnerable people, you'll need to have a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.
