CCA JOINS QUAKERS IN DEFENDING JURORS' RIGHTS



This week, members of Christian Climate Action (CCA) joined the Quakers in recreating an act of worship that was held outside in Gracechurch Street in 1670. The outdoor meeting all those years ago was held in defiance of the authorities who had banned Quakers from gathering in their local meeting house, and it led to the arrest of Quaker leaders William Penn and William Mead. What happened at the following trial was one of the greatest challenges to the freedom a jury seen in UK judicial history - until today.

At trial the jury found Penn and Mead innocent of any wrongdoing. Jury members were then themselves imprisoned by the judge for contempt of court, until they came to different verdict. Holding to their consciences, they refused to do this until they were released and their own verdict was upheld. Thus the right of juries to be free from inappropriate judicial interference was reaffirmed and has remained one of the tenets of the UK judicial system ever since.

The aim of this month's recreation was to highlight that this right is again coming under increasing pressure, as judges in human rights cases - including climate cases - have recently been insisting that juries disregard their consciences and ignore defendants' reasons for their actions.

Defend our Juries

13th - 21st April

UK-wide

A week of action across England and Wales and at the Royal Courts of Justice upholding that 'Jurors have an absolute right to acquit a defendant according to their conscience'.

As detailed above (CCA Joins Quakers in Defending Jurors' Rights), some judges have recently been denying both defendants and jurors their rights by



restricting what defendants can say in climate action trials to explain their actions, and by limiting what jurors are allowed to hear.

In response, Defend our Juries National Week of Action aims to cover each of the 90+ courts in the UK with creative actions including court sittings, sign-holder vigils, outreach and street theatre.

There will be a special show of solidarity on the 18th April at the Royal Courts of Justice for Trudi Warner who will be on trial.

Trudi was arrested for holding up a sign outside a court declaring the right of a jury to make decisions of conscience and is now at risk of prison. More people have followed her actions, ready to face the consequences for defending jurors' rights. This is your chance to join them and to show support for Trudie.
