Role description

An exciting new opportunity for a Team Coordinator as we pioneer new ways of pursuing our mission on a team basis.



Churches Together in Cornwall (CTC) is a network that encourages local Christian unity for mission, partnering with churches, prayer groups, organisations and networks across the county in pursuit of our vision 'Inspiring Unity – Sharing our gifts'.

The CTC network is managed by the CTC Executive, comprising denominational church leaders and their Ecumenical Officers, together with co-opted volunteers representing different communities in Cornwall. Day-to-day operations are run by the CTC Steering Group, working alongside a growing number of independent Liaison Groups covering different subject areas, local Churches Together groups and Local Ecumenical Partnerships. The Steering Group ensures the delivery of our mission with an emphasis on prayer, communications and the support of local activities. For details of our work visit <u>ctcinfohub.org</u>.

This new home-based voluntary position will act as the first point of contact for CTC, working together with the CTC Steering Group and Liaison Groups in supporting numerous projects at county and local level, and also with our colleagues in Churches Together in neighbouring counties and Churches Together in England, who will provide advice and training. Some travel will be involved, though many meetings are currently on Zoom. Expenses will be paid.

The Team Coordinator will be guided by the Steering Group, reporting through that to the CTC chair (currently the Bishop of Truro).

As this is a new position there is considerable flexibility in tailoring the role to the skills and interests of the applicant; 'job-shares' may also be possible. The post replaces that of the existing CTC Missioner, who completes his period of office in May 2022, and is available from April 2022 to allow for handover.

The post is available to anyone, lay or ordained, with a passion for Christian unity.
