#### FAIRTRADE FORTNIGHT

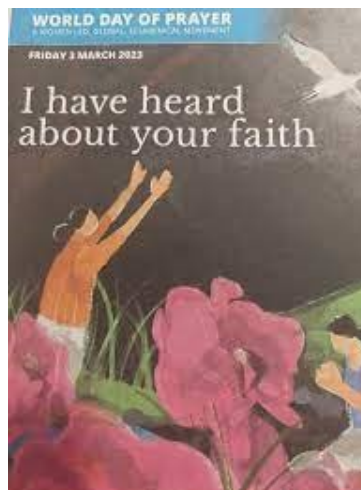
