


FPCT JUSTICE AND PEACE ACTION GROUP

Our next meeting is **10 Feb at 2pm at St Mary's Church Hall, Killigrew St**, when the focus will be the **Olympic Truce** or Ekecheiria, an ancient Greek tradition revived by the International Olympic Committee, calling for a global ceasefire during the Olympic Games to ensure safe passage and participation for athletes, promoting peace, dialogue, and unity through sport. The Winter Olympics are taking place in Milano/Cortina from 6-22 Feb.
