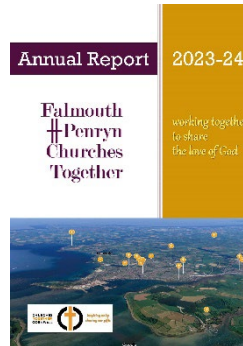
FPCT AGM

It has been a privilege to be able to serve in this way, but God has moved me on so that younger fellow Christians will be able to "put their stamp" on the important work that FPCT does in His name.

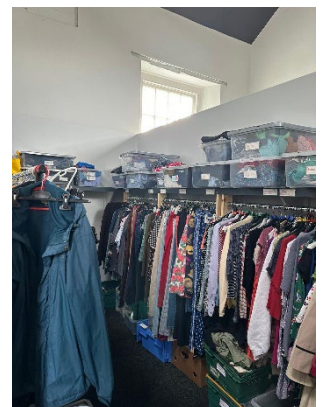
