

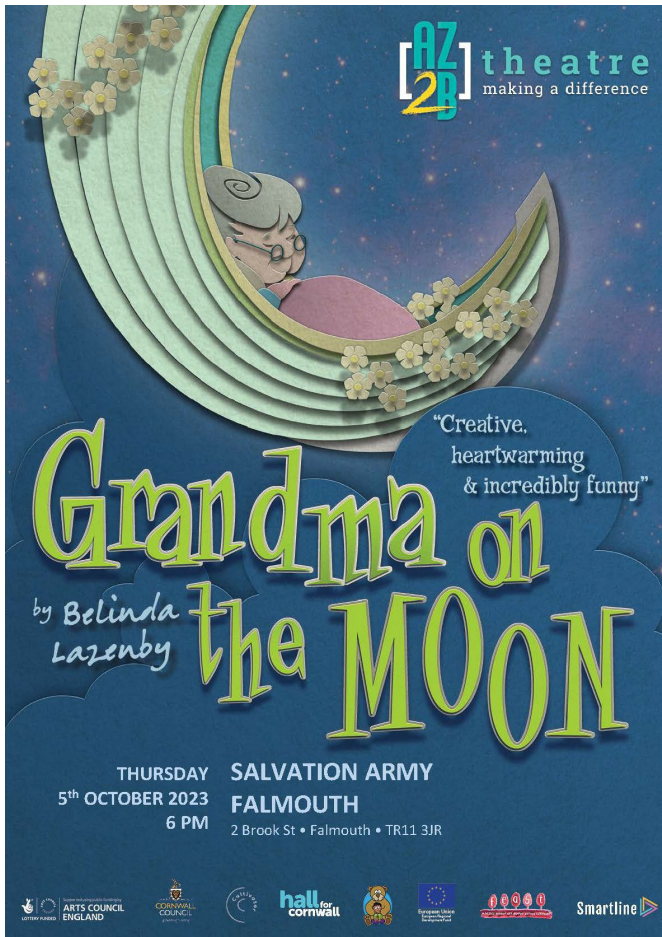

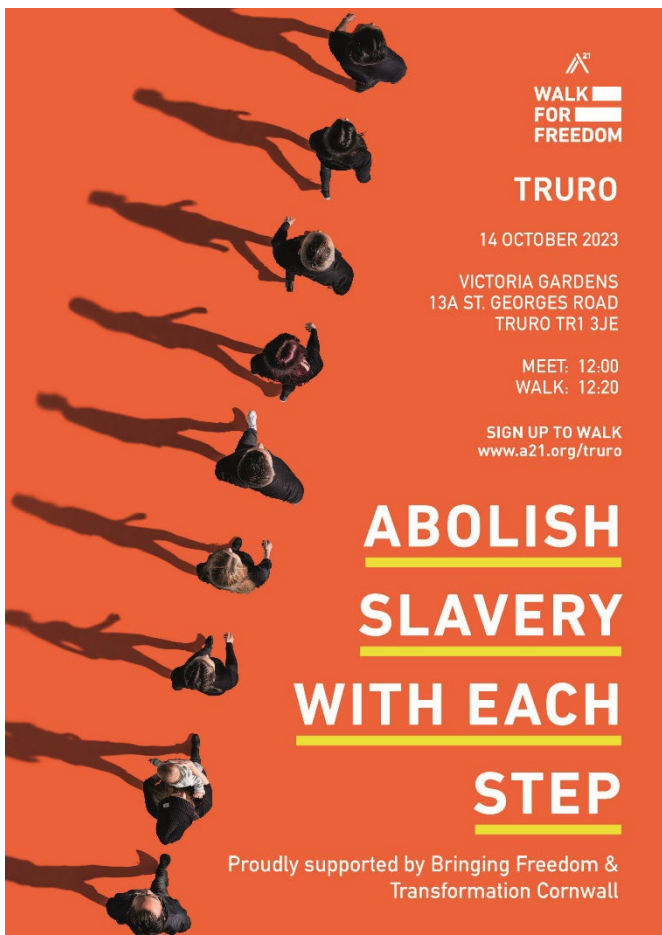
Come and hear about the current extent of Modern Slavery in Cornwall, what is being done to combat it and what we can do to help.
