SILENT VIGIL FOR THE HOLY LAND

7th October 2025

We have all been deeply affected by the ongoing war in Israel/Palestine, especially the huge amount of suffering in Gaza. With that in mind, there will be a Silent Vigil for the Holy Land from 10.00am to 12.00 noon on The Moor in Falmouth on Tuesday 7 October, which is the second anniversary of the beginning of the war.

There will be no flags, no banners, just prayerful people gathering to pray for peace in the Holy Land. Anyone is welcome to join in for as long or as short as they are able.

We plan to have some brief A5 leaflets available to hand out to people if they ask us what we are there for. The vigil would be to uphold all people involved and affected by the conflict.

If you are unable to join us on the 7 October, why not spend some time in prayer for the situation?

Dear Friends,

We hope this message finds you well. As always, we deeply appreciate your unwavering support for our community.

Sadly we continue to see a steady increase in people needing emergency food parcels.

Challenging Times: Due to the current economic situation, we have a lot more clients, many of whom are working and still finding it hard to make ends meet.

Our Response: To address this urgent need, we continue to purchase essential items ourselves. The average weekly food shop costs us £450 a week (roughly £1800 a month), so this is not a sustainable solution. We rely on the generosity of our community to keep our food bank operational, therefore we would ask that you can spread the word on our behalf, which we would really appreciate.

How You Can Help: Every small contribution makes a significant difference. If you can spare a little extra, it will go a long way in supporting those who rely on our service. We are extremely short of the following supplies at the moment:

- Tinned fruit
- Pasta Sauce jars
- Sugar
- Tinned meat
- Semi skimmed long life milk
- Tuna
- Meat soup/ Veg soup
- Coffee
- Tinned potatoes
- Tinned hot dogs
- Tinned meatballs
- Bottles of squash
- Cans of 'pop' e.g. coca cola, lemonade etc (we give out individual cans for the single boxes)

- Tinned tomatoes
- Baked beans
- Essential toiletries, particularly deodorant
