Pastor Lorenzo: Free!

On 17 January 2025, Pastor Lorenzo was released from prison!

This incredible news came as the result of negotiations to release 553 political prisoners between Cuba, the Vatican and the administration of US President Joe Biden.

We were fortunate enough to <u>receive a video</u> from Pastor Lorenzo's family of the exact moment he stepped out of the prison gates and was reunited with his wife, daughter and son. It was a powerful reminder of the importance of sustained advocacy and prayer, which we all have been undertaking since his arrest in July 2021.

You signed petitions, wrote letters to Members of Parliament, and

protested with us outside the Cuban Embassy in London.

Countless prayers were prayed and words of encouragement were sent to the family throughout that time. **Thank you!**



'I realise I can heal.' Equipping communities in Colombia

Last year we travelled to Colombia to roll out more of our psychosocial workshops, designed for both human rights defenders and survivors of human rights violations. Those who defend human rights are also likely to experience trauma themselves, as they live in the same context as those they are supporting.

The training has had a profound impact already, with participants like Pastor Jairo* telling us:

'This workshop is like a breath of fresh air for me...I didn't know I had trauma and needed help. I just felt pain and was directionless, but listening to this workshop, I realise I can heal. I feel hope.'

More good news: Mubarak Bala released

Justice in cases involving violations of freedom of religion or belief can feel all too rare.

We're therefore encouraged to share the news that **Mubarak Bala**, **President of the Nigerian Humanist Society**, has been released from prison after more than four years behind bars.

Mr Bala was arrested in 2020 after being accused of insulting Islam on social media. His case has served as a reminder of the incompatibility of blasphemy laws with the freedoms of expression, and religion or belief, and how they can drive religious extremism.

We welcome and celebrate his release, whilst remaining concerned

for his ongoing safety.
