ECUMENICAL PILGRIMAGE OF PEACE

The Archbishop of Canterbury, Pope Francis and the leader of the Methodist Church area are visiting South Sudan for 3 days at the end of January. This had been postponed till now for reasons of insecurity.

FALMOUTH PENDENNIS HEADLAND AND SHIPS AND CASTLES SWIMMING POOL

COP 15 ON BIODIVERSITY

The resulting Biodiversity Pledge is a major milestone in conservation. 200 nations have agreed to preserve 30% of the earth for nature by the close of the decade.

HOUSING FIRST THEN MEETING OTHER NEEDS

In Covid lockdown, 37,430 homeless people were temporarily housed. In June 2021, 26,167 of these had been found permanent accommodation. The cost of a rough sleeper per annum is £20,128, in police, hospital and prisons. To find permanent accommodation is £1,421. In several countries e.g. Finland this 'Housing First' policy has been very successful.
