GOOD NEWS

- **BRITISH LEGION CENTENARY**
 - Tomorrow is Armistice Day and Sunday is Remembrance Sunday. The British Legion was founded 100 years ago after the end of the first world war to support and help the Armed Forces and their families.
 - Poppies will be worn this week, commemorating not only those who died in conflicts but also as a sign of hope for peace although this is not widely known.
- **ETHICAL SHOPPING**
 - Shoppers are shunning brands with poor track records on ethics; research has shown 40% of UK consumers have stopped shopping with brands or companies that do not treat their staff or supply chains fairly.
- **COVID PILL**
 - The UK Medicines Regulator has approved a pill that treats vulnerable patients diagnosed with Covid, cutting hospital admissions and deaths by 50%, a gamechanger according to the Health Secretary.

 - France is passing a law that sets a minimum price for online book deliveries to protect bookshops from internet giants.
