WOODLAND TRUST

In pioneering research with the University of Nottingham, it was found that 1.8 million of the UK's oldest trees were unrecorded in England alone. Meanwhile its project partner the National Trust surveyed 22 of its estates in Devon and East Anglia, safeguarding more than 2,500 special trees/
