### EDUCATION

EDUCATION SUNDAY was on 11<sup>th</sup> September. At our recent J and P meeting one of our group members shared her research on Justice in Education. 87% of the world's children do get a primary education. Nearly half of those in secondary education don't complete their studies.

Education is a gateway to the eradication of poverty. One member when qualified is then able and expected to pay for other family members to go to school in some countries. The Fair Trade movement enables especially women to learn business and management skills which enable them to greatly improve their prospects. Reasons for non school attendance include the Taliban curtailing women's activities and independence, modern day slavery, child labour, racial and other denigration eg Dalits in the caste system.
