

Reset The Debt Update from the Joint Public Issues Team

This week, the government announced another extension to the **evictions ban**, stopping evictions notices being served for another six weeks. Yet over 445,00 adults have fallen behind on rent since the pandemic began. **1** in **3** Universal Credit claimants have seen their debts rise during lockdown.

As Churches, we want everyone to be able to flourish as we seek to recover from the pandemic. But debt is weighing so many low-income families down. We need a better solution. The government have the opportunity to put secure support in place now to take responsibility for the household debt built up because of lockdown. That's why we're asking them to **Reset The Debt**.
