Free 'Talk Learn Do' trainings coming up

This winter QSA is running workshops for practitioners on Talk Learn Do, a practical session supporting parents to talk with their children about money. They are designed for practitioners to deliver as part of parenting support work, but are more widely adaptable, with lots of well- designed activities. TLD is funded by the Money and Pensions Service, who meet the cost of the workshop for each participant. We're keen to share this with our network as we know many of you are looking out for training opportunities. Some sessions will be delivered by Made of Money staff and others by Campaign for Learning staff. We hope to announce more Made of Money

trainings soon.

What is Talk Learn Do (TLD)?

TLD is a facilitator led group session that encourages parents of 3–11-year-olds to talk to their children about money and create opportunities for their children to experience managing it. The programme provides parents with tools, ideas, and fun activities to help include money in everyday conversations and activities.

With the increase in personal finance related news and ongoing cost of living pressures, there continues to be a demand for financial wellbeing work with parents and training for professionals who support them.

The Money and Pensions Service is working with Quaker Social Action and Campaign for Learning to expand its training programme for professionals who support parents across the UK. The training is free and open to organisations across the UK. Each organisation will initially be allocated one training space on a first come first served basis. Further spaces to be allocated if available.
