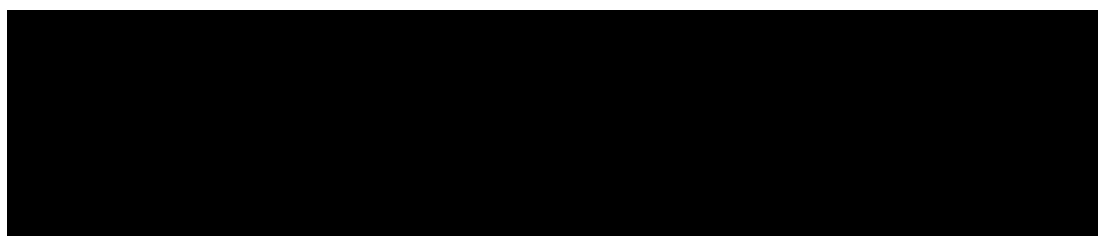


Cornwall Community Foundation's out of county supporters raise over £200,000 at celebratory event in London
