


Gregoriana at Dorchester Abbey

Historic England publishes new Heritage at Risk Register

The 2023 Heritage at Risk Register was released by Historic England on Thursday 9 November and gives a snapshot of historic places in England at risk of being lost.

We were pleased to see Newport
Minster listed as one of the 29
churches that have been removed from
the list since 2022. You may remember
that we were able to award Newport
Minster a £612,000 Heritage Stimulus
Fund grant – enabling them to carry out
urgent repairs to their building.

However, 934 listed churches are listed among the most endangered historic buildings in England, highlighting why our work to keep the UK's historic churches well maintained is as important as ever.
