Good news: 33 churches saved for the future

Dear Supporter,

We're delighted to share with you that we've been able to award £473,750 to thirty-three churches to keep them open and in good repair.

Phillipa Cook, the PCC Secretary and Project Coordinator from Great Brickhall St Mary the Virgin Church in Buckinghamshire shared with us just what a grant from us has meant for their Grade II Listed church, where the roof is failing.

"A number of ceiling panels are at risk of collapsing; one already having done so. Any delay with the work would result in further damage and increase the possibility of having to close the church and suspend all services and activities."

So many churches – like St Mary the Virgin – are facing severe challenges just to keep their doors open and we risk losing not only the precious heritage inside these churches, but also valuable community support taking place inside. 


33 churches saved for the future by our latest grants




Now that the finalists have been unveiled, anticipation is building towards the awards ceremony itself, which takes place on Monday 6


