We had a clear sense that this season is one of evangelism and witness, the Gospel being preached fully with signs, wonders and miracles, (Hebrews 2: 1-4 & Psalm 45: 1). We also had pictures that suggested restoration, renewal and a stripping away to reveal the gold of those that are those called to receive Jesus, as well as a sense of the importance of reaching the next generation. From this time of prayer, the following became key priorities for the 2022/23 season.

Alongside bringing refreshment to the Body of Christ, to further develop Filling Station Falmouth as an unashamedly Gospel ministry where all who gather will hear a clear and simple message of God's unfailing love for them, delivered in a way where the kindness of God shines through, bringing a change of heart towards Him and leading to salvation, supported by the signs, wonders and miracles that accompany such a message.

Developing a dedicated worship team from a broad base that can serve the Filling Station Falmouth and develop over time a strong working relationship with those that are leading the meetings in order to best host the ministry of the Holy Spirit each time we gather.

Developing prayer ministry teams that are well trained and fully accountable within the Body of Christ to encourage a safe and consistent ministry of signs, wonders and miracles, with power.

Develop Filling Station Falmouth as a ministry that engages well with young people and those on the margins of society.

As you may be aware, we resume the pattern of meeting monthly on the second Monday of each month, starting on 12th September at 7 pm. We have an exciting new venue at Falmouth Rugby Club which is a really great opportunity to engage in mission in perhaps a slightly different way to before.

We also have plans to hold a Filling Station Conference late in Spring 2023, where we are currently looking to Prof. Mark Birch-Machin and a team from Speakers of Life in Newcastle to come down and minister. Mark is a member of the British Isles Council of Prophets, and ministers in the prophetic both on the streets, in the marketplaces and in the business world.
